

MINUTES OF THE 26TH ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING OF ISCCM HELD ON 29th FEBRUARY 2020 AT 5.30 PM AT HYDERABAD

The Twenty sixth Annual General Body Meeting of the Indian Society of Critical Care Medicine was held on 29th February 2020 at 5.30 P.M. at Hyderabad International Convention Centre, Hyderabad

Dr Rajesh Chandra Mishra welcomed all the members present. The meeting was adjourned for required quorum.

1 Appreciation to Participating companies

The quorum was complete. The President Dr Subhal Dixit welcomed members and called the meeting to order. He Introduced Dr Dhruva Chaudhry, President-Elect, Dr Yatin Mehta, Immediate Past President on dais and requested Dr Rajesh Chandra Mishra to start the proceedings.

4. Confirmation of Minutes of the last Annual General Body meeting held on 2nd February 2019 at Mumbai

The minutes of the last AGM were confirmed. Dr Rajesh Pande proposed and Dr Tushar Patel seconded and minutes were passed.

5. To confirm the Audited Statements of accounts for the year 2018-19.

Dr Manish Munjal proposed and Dr Atul Kulkarni seconded passing of accounts and Audited accounts for year 2018-2019 were passed.

6. Business arising out of the minutes of last AGM

7. The Annual report of Indian College of Critical Care Medicine

Dr Rajesh Chandra Mishra – there are 203 institutes. New hospital accreditation in 2019-20 is 17. There are a total of 497 teachers. New 99 teachers are approved. New ISCCM courses have started. ECMO fellowship is for 1 year.

The Fellowship in Neurocritical care and Online Fellowship in Critical care Ultrasound course has been also started.

Dr Subhal Dixit informed that third centre for Neurocritical Care course is Kovai Medical Centre.

New respiratory therapist course with IARC has been started.

There were no issues and report was taken as passed.

8. The annual report of the IJCCM

Dr Rajesh Chandra Mishra - It will be covered in report of General Secretary.

9. Name of Delhi branch

Dr Deepak Govil suggested that name of Delhi and NCR branch should be changed back to as Delhi branch. Dr Dhruva Chaudhry - NOIDA is still with Delhi. The name should remain as Delhi and NCR branch. Dr Deepak Govil – The name of branch can be Delhi and Noida rather than as Delhi and NCR branch.

Dr Anirban Hom Choudhuri - name should continue as Delhi and NCR branch as it is broad term and include places other than Faridabad and Gurgaon. Dr Deepak Govil objected that the name NCR causes confusion in election because Noida comes in Central zone and Delhi comes in North zone.

Dr Dhruva Chaudhry – by Delhi and NCR half of Haryana, one third of western UP and Rajasthan comes under it. The name should be Delhi and Noida branch.

Dr Subhal Dixit concluded that it will be renamed as Delhi and Noida branch. Faridabad and Gurgaon will be separate branches.

10. General Secretary`s Annual report

Dr Rajesh Chandra Mishra made a detailed presentation of activities done during the year.

Growth of ISCCM

At present there are 87 branches and total membership is 12120. He also informed about number of active, de-active and deceased members.

New award

Dr Rajesh Chandra Mishra – from this year new award has been introduced - Best Research Paper award. The prize for this award is Rs 50,000. This year it has been given and It will be continued every year.

Dr Subhal Dixit - of the 3 winners, the first winner will be given ISCCM best research paper award. The second winner will be given Hansraj Nayyar award. Both papers will be presented in plenary of 15 minutes each.

Dr Dhruva Chaudhry - we want to encourage research and hence new research award has been introduced. He hoped that members agreed with it. Members agreed.

Tie up with other societies

Tie up have been done with other societies. Mou has been done with Critical Care Society of China and South Africa. Dr Subhal Dixit had visited China for their annual conference.

There is also MOU with Neuro Critical Care society (SNCC – India). A joint Asia Pacific Neuro Critical Care Conference will be also held.

Dr Subhal Dixit – a MOU with International Society on Thrombosis and Haemostasis has been also signed.

Research

It has been tried to encourage research HERMES study and DISSECT study results have been presented. For HERMES study, services of CRO were taken. There are some proposals which are hoped to be accepted. ISCCM will be aggressive and active for research.

Criticare 2020

Dr Rajesh Chandra Mishra -toughest target was to get delegates. Everybody wanted discounted registration and we gave possible discount in regional conferences. Across media people were reached and result is that we could get substantial number of non- members as delegates. It was tried to involve branches and result is that there are 3,197 registration excluding today`s few registration. The members applauded.

The data can be presented in every AGM and we can have trend of going up or down of registration.

It was highlighted that almost 800 non-members have registered. Dr Deepak Govil - they should be converted in members. it was agreed for trying to convert non-members to members.

Dr Arindam Kar appreciated and congratulated the decision of allowing registration for only workshops as otherwise 428 delegates would have been missed.

Certain workshops are in high demand. The society should decide for how to handle them next year. It is to be thought for what should be done for encouraging people to participate in workshops which are not in demand. Mechanical Ventilation, 4c, ECHO and Ultrasound and nursing workshops were in high demand. For ECHO few were cancelled as unfortunately could not accommodate machines and space. Next year probably whoever taking course will have to decide regarding seat increase.

Dr Rajesh Chandra Mishra showed photo on first day of plenary at Criticare 2020. It was mesmerising to look at around 1,500 delegates in plenary session and a totally full hall. The members applauded. It is rewarding and encouraging for us.

New studies

There will be new study on balanced fluids,

DISSECT study will extend further. Grant also has been received for it. It is being looked forward for many more studies.

ISCCM Text book

ISCCM Text book is in pipeline. Dr Dhruva Chaudhry and Dr Subhal Dixit have promised that in Criticare 2021, Ahmedabad conference they will release and launch it. The members applauded.

Dr Dhruva Chaudhry - It will be Indian textbook of critical care medicine by ISCCM and we will require participation and help from all for publishing it timely.

ISCCM guidelines

5 guidelines have been submitted to IJCCM for publication on NIV, DVT, ICU Planning and design, Central Venous Catheterization and Management 2020 and Tracheostomy. There are position papers on that.

International publication for World Federation

It was amazing that we were part of it. Dr Rajesh Chandra Mishra - when Dr Atul Kulkarni had wrote he had undoubtedly reacted that it will be published on first priority and that has happened. It is pride for us that it is so well elaborated in the paper that everybody must read for how intensive care has grown up in India in last 25 years. Members applauded.

IJCCM

IJCCM is doing fantastic under leadership of Dr Atul Kulkarni. 1400 manuscripts have been submitted in 2019 and 153 articles have been published. Articles published in special issues are 47. 4 special issues have been published - 1 on antimicrobial Guidelines, Neurocritical Care, Transfusion and Poisoning.

Orcid will be slowly made mandatory.

IJCCM is now financially self-sufficient. Now every conference, abstracts will be also published. The scientific language editor Dr Amrita Prayag has been appointed. There is a supplement consisting of 2 guidelines on antimicrobial use in India.

Omnicuris association

Mou has been signed with Omnicuris for online CME. They will record 4 hours lecture of 4 faculties They will get it recognised by Maharashtra Medical Council and there will be credit points for that. Dr Subhal Dixit - this is association approved by 16 medical associations from different states. It will be online CME. Masterclasses will be recorded. They will be uploaded and run on ISCCM academy. Will get credit points from 16 different medical associations.

ISCCM Digital learning platform

Webinars: though launched few months ago, they are hit. Some of webinars like Dengue, Fluid therapy on airway management and Corona had thousands of attendees. Corona webinar was attended by almost 4,000 attendees.

Podcasts: There were 4 Podcasts this year which were coordinated by Dr Kapil Borawake.

All this will be available under learning platform of ISCCM academy.

Medicolegal support

Medicolegal support from the experts has been made available for free. Even for course there is a 30% discount.

Dr Subhal Dixit – we have got grant for 1,000 complimentary Medico legal course registration for ISCCM members and 2,500 calls of 20 minutes. Medico legal free consultation will be given by Institute of Medicine and Law to ISCCM members. Members applauded.

Social responsibility

ISCCM has started doing social responsibility activities. Educational material was distributed. Medicines were donated for floods in Kerala, Maharashtra and Karnataka. Doxycycline was arranged for sending to all these 3 states on high priority.

Jaypee Brothers – official publisher

Jaypee Brothers are official publishers of ISCCM for next 5 years. Mou has been signed with them. They give special rate for everything requested and it is like no profit or loss for both of us.

Critical Care Communications

The editor is Dr Dhruva Chaudhry and he is well supported by Dr Mohan Gurjar who has done extremely well. The last 3 to 4 issues where there was cost has been done free by event manager – Meetings and More. Dr Rajesh Chandra Mishra thanked them and members applauded.

ICMR letter

A letter has been given to ICMR for presenting views of NLEM anti- infective list.

ISCCM Day

The theme was precise nutrition with precision. Under vision of Dr Subhal Dixit a single day activity was planned and supported by Fresenius Kabi to do a program about awareness on nutrition. The slides were sent to all branches and it was done in almost all branches covering 51 cities and 85 branches had participated.

SNCC membership

There is a special offer from SNCC for membership and they are giving 50% discount to ISCCM members for their membership.

Social media

First time ISCCM has been active on social media. The Facebook was led by Dr Manish Munjal. Dr Rajesh Chandra Mishra appreciated him for his extremely good job. The members applauded. Twitter was handled by Dr Sanjay Dhanuka, LinkedIn by Dr Jayeshkumar Dobariya and Instagram by Dr Deven Juneja. All these will be now soon managed by professional. Everything will be under ISCCM academy and there will be regularly something for keeping connected with ISCCM.

Finances

Dr Rajesh Chandra Mishra – Finance area was the biggest challenge I faced when I took over as General Secretary. The huge amount was being lost as GST penalty as we were not getting advice from CA.

Two accountants have been appointed. GST consultant - Talati and Talati, reputed firm was also appointed. It took them 3 months for bringing penalty to nil. The members applauded.

It was felt that a better CA is needed. Everything has been handed over to Talati and Talati. From April 2020, Ambavat Jain and Associates will be relieved and Talati and Talati will be CA and consultant for GST, accounting and all related issues.

Zoom meetings

Zoom meetings have helped immensely. It is not possible to travel every time. Need to be connected. Whatever we have been able to achieve today in ISCCM office and conference its 70 % contribution is due to zoom. Hopefully, it will continue.

Purchase of new office.

Dr Rajesh Chandra Mishra – The neighboring Unit 15 office has been purchased at Dadar. The members applauded.

World Congress bid

We have won World congress bid which was being looked upon since last couple of years. 2025 world congress will be at Delhi.

Oration

Past president oration has been given to Dr Kapil Zirpe.

ISCCM oration was given to Dr Mathew Cherian.

Best ISCCM research paper has been awarded to Dr Vijai Williams.

Honorary FICCM – key EC and ICCM Board members travelled to Pune due to ill health of FICCM awardee, Brig V S Kolhe and he was given his award at Pune.

1 nomination was received for Executive Committee Elected Members (South Zone) and no nominations were received for Executive Committee Elected Members (East Zone). Hence, there is a 1 vacant post of Executive Committee Elected Members (South Zone) and 2 vacant posts of Executive Committee Elected Members (East Zone) for 2020-22. Accordingly, as per Constitution the nominations have been invited for the vacant posts and their elections will be held at Annual General Body meeting on 29th Feb 2020 during Criticare 2020, Hyderabad conference.

12. Elections for Executive Committee Elected members from South Zone – 1 Post and East Zone – 2 Posts

Dr Subhal Dixit – Dr Kapil Zirpe, Chief Election Commissioner has requested Dr Manish Munjal, member of Election Commission to conduct elections. Dr Subhal Dixit requested Dr Manish Munjal to conduct elections

Dr Manish Munjal – 1 nomination of Dr Venkat Raman Kola has been received for post of Executive Committee member from South Zone - 1 vacant post. He declared Dr Venkat Raman Kola as elected as unopposed.

For post of Executive Committee member from East zone (2 posts) 4 nominations of Dr Vijay Kumar Mishra, Ranchi, Dr Tapas Kumar Sahoo, Ranchi, Dr Sharmili Sinha, Bhubaneswar and Dr Ajoy Sarkar, Kolkata have been received. Elections have to be done for these posts.

Dr Dhruva Chaudhry - all 4 candidates can decide that whether they want to withdraw so elections can be avoided. There was no withdrawal of nominations. The ballot papers were distributed and elections were conducted by secret ballot. Dr Srinivas Samavedam enquired for whether voting had to be done by all members or only East zone members. Dr Subhal Dixit - All members can vote at the Annual General meeting.

Dr Manish Munjal declared elections results. Total polling was 218 and 7 votes were rejected for various reasons. Dr Manish Munjal - Dr Tapas Kumar Sahoo (114 votes) and Dr Sharmili Sinha (112 votes) have polled higher number of votes and they are declared as elected as Executive Committee members from East Zone.

13.To discuss about the Constitution Amendments

Dr Rajesh Chandra Miishra - proposed constitution amendments were emailed to all members. As per Constitution members had to send their suggestions till 20th February 2020 regarding them. Since no suggestions have been received regarding amendments they are being taken as passed. The proposed Constitution amendments were proposed by Dr Rajesh Pande and seconded by Dr Y P Singh and Dr Vimal Bhardwaj and passed.

14. Presentation of the report of the Organising Secretary for 27th Annual Conference of Indian Society of Critical Care Medicine Criticare 2021 at Ahmedabad

Dr Srinivas Samavedam presented report of Criticare 2021. He is grateful to ISCCM for opportunity given to him for responsibility of organizing Criticare 2021 in vibrant city of Ahmedabad and colorful state of Gujarat. It is his privilege and honor to organize next annual conference. Members applauded. The conference will be held in state of art convention center - Mahatma Gandhi Convention Center.

The theme has been decided as safety and efficiency amidst resource limitation. All lectures, workshops and skill stations will be directed at this important concern. While continuing with excellent workshops conducted at Criticare 2020 it is proposed to include workshops of managing management skills as well as soft skills for intensivists. It will be looked to tie up with IIM Ahmedabad to execute this workshop. Dr Anuj Clerk has been working on error prevention module. His help will be taken for constructing standalone workshop on error prevention module.

Dr Tejas Karmata – for Error prevention module Dr Ritesh Shah is also equally involved. Dr Dhruva Chaudhry - we all are from India and will work together. Members applauded.

Organ transplant is growing by leaps and bounds. Awareness of criteria and problem during organ transplant also need to be address when we talk of safety and efficiency amidst resource limitation. It will be addressed in standalone workshop.

We are in process of identifying international faculties. Dr Deepak Govil has contacted with key names which will be revealed shortly. Dr Srinivas Samavedam promised to try to match standards set by Dr Rajesh Chandra Mishra and Scientific Committee of 2020 in delivering equally good workshops and conference at Criticare 2021.

It is expected that members will attend Criticare 2021 workshops and conference in large numbers and make it successful.

Dr Srinivas Samavedam thanked members and concluded presentation of his Criticare 2021 report. Members applauded.

On behalf of all branch of Gujarat state, Dr Raj Raval invited all members to Criticare 2021, Ahmedabad.

15. Presentation of budget by Dr Shilpushp Bhosale, Treasurer

Dr Rajesh Chandra Mishra presented and informed key budgeted income and expenses financials.


He thanked members and hoped to see them in large numbers at Criticare 2021, Ahmedabad.
